FOR THE SHABBOS TABLE: THE FLAME DANCE

This week we add a new light to our menorah every day. The Rebbe Rashab would sit by the Chanukah candles for half an hour after lighting and listen to candles. The Chanukah candles are so special and can teach us many lessons. If you watch closely you will see the candles are dancing- just like you! What makes a candle dance? The flame wants to soar very high, all the way up. But, the wick holds it down. Together this makes a flame dance - going back and forth. We also dance like the candles. Our neshama wants to go up close to Hashem (just like the flame) and only do holy things like learning Torah, but our body (just like the wick) makes us stay down here and do our work in this physical world. Our purpose in this world is to keep doing the "flame dance" and use all our physical things to serve Hashem. Keep dancing and a Freilichin Chanukah!
